Guidelines: The tournament is open to boys and girls 9 & Under who can serve, return, rally and score.

Court & Equipment: The tournament will be played outdoors on a 3/4 size court using a mini orange (slow and low bouncing) ball.

Format: Players will play 4 matches. Each match will last 10 minutes and a tie break style scoring method will be used. Players will serve for two points at a time.

Parent responsibility: During the event parents are expected to stay and look after their son/ daughter when they are not playing.

Points table: At the end of the summer season a special prize will be awarded to the series winner. A table will be produced after each event to show latest standings. Points will be received as follows:

Entering a tournament = 10 points

For every point won in tournament = 1 point

For winning tournament = 20 points

For second position = 10 points
